

A fraggle sang in Berkeley Square.

Feynman said regarding NASA that the question of whom to scapegoat was futile and what people in his shoes needed to ask was “how do you educate the child?” - where the ‘child’ was the administration of NASA, compared to a child running in the road, being told off by a parent, in Feynman’s analogy the scientists who warned that the Challenger disaster would happen but who were ignored.

Today the world looks at most of western society and says “do they deserve to live?” and I think it’s the same type of error in questioning. The question to ask is “can they survive? Is there a way for them to survive and integrate into the rest of the human race? And how much of the rest of the human race will survive rather than be sucked into the disaster the west is somewhat insanely taking to new levels of horror worldwide?”

Around two decades ago I saw online videos roaming about the place, made by apparently militant maoists, mocking the entire western world as a conveyor belt of hyperconsumer sheeple - it may still have eluded their notice that China is much the same, but that’s not relevant to what I’m trying to tell you, just bear it in mind for another day.

What I’m saying is that today we see rich and poor people alike being rinsed out by capitalism, price inflation eating them all alive, and they all (a) roll over and take it and (b) blame each other and don’t fight the source, they demand that ‘the other guy’ give them ‘their share’.

So those militant maoists weren’t wrong at all. Rich and poor, left and right, ‘clever’ and ‘stupid’, Britons are all rolling over together and subjecting themselves now to what they’ve subjected everyone else to in hard and soft ways. We are all on Prince Harry’s kill list now, even Prince Harry and his family. We’re all being sacrificed to the suicide bomber that is capitalism.

Teachers. Nurses. Let’s start with that. Yes, ask for enough money and food. No, not ‘because you are a teacher’. Teachers: you produced the 70% racist population, the brexit-voting and neoliberal population, the crusaders who go and bomb people for america, you make em. Sure, you can have enough food, but NOT because you sit there grooming terrorists. Nurses - you are not special, thanks for your job, thanks to lots of us for our ‘jobs’ and thanks to us ALL for being a community, and yes, we all should have enough, but no, don’t say it’s because your identity warrants that you deserve more than certain others in society. That’s the problem not the solution, the whole ‘more than others’ thing. Whether stated directly, after the custom of Johnson, or indirectly, like nurses saying “I do a job which entitles me to a level of security which I couldn’t ask for if I didn’t have a wage slave job at all, or if my job was perhaps not unionised, or if my job was not describable in a way which makes it sound, if marketed well, like a great gift from me to society, as though I go in there every day like Alan Alda from MASH and save people’s lives myself, with nothing but a plastic fork and a few jokes”.

One of your campaigns or a comment maybe said, provocatively, that ‘they’ can end the suffering of all sorts of people right now, not tomorrow, but today. Well the 70% of

Britons who racially discriminate against me can stop today, not in forty years or a hundred and seventy. Today. That's where it starts. With you, not those who do to you what you are already guilty of.

Carlin said it best and I shall try to write this like Carlin not Chomsky and end it amorphously and briefly: on the topic of the people who run our society, at all levels, 'garbage in, garbage out'. Every 'tory' or 'neoliberal' was taught by British teachers and is tended to by British nurses. You sit there nursing and teaching nazis, helping nazis be nazis, being nazis. Teachers in Venezuela, perhaps, or Palestine, are the sort of people YOU mean when you use the word 'teacher' - and yet what you point to isn't a teacher but just nazi groomers, all ye do, all ye ever do, is groom more nazis.

If you stop asking for yourself and ask for everyone, your collective voice will become overpowering. And if you ask for everyone who's the first person you ask FROM? It's yourself. Stop being an idiot. That's the first thing you can do, personally, for everyone else in the whole world, whoever you are. I began my attempt at that at birth itself, and no doubt I am not alone in this. Clearly, though, it's a minority attitude and most in society are glad to pursue the lauded goal of excelling in idiocy, as ostentatiously as possible. But don't be too hard on them, my fellow post-humans, you see their approach is quite natural. It is natural to be an idiot and it is natural to become extinct. Experience selects great things from what unfolds, and to do that it must make much unfold, and to do that much of it must be banal, pointless, idiotic and ephemeral.

There are two key things to remember, one short of powerpoint presentation minimum requirements and screenwriter minimum requirements: if you transcend spacetime then it doesn't matter if humanity 'becomes extinct', and more importantly, in my opinion, if you transcend spacetime then we may easily divert that extinction and have something really rather splendid here on this rock of fraggles.
